## EXOTIC PANAMA CANAL

### March 10-20, 2010

#### Itinerary Details

#### DAY 1 WEDNESDAY, March 10

Transportation will be provided to the Minneapolis airport today for our flight to Ft. Lauderdale, FL, where we will board the Island Princess. Transfers are included from the airport in Florida to the cruise terminal. We set sail at 5pm.

#### DAY 2 THURSDAY, March 11

Today is a day at sea. This gives us the opportunity to familiarize ourselves with the ship, relax at the spa or take in the vast cruise activities that are offered.

#### DAY 3 FRIDAY, March 12

Our first port of call is **Ocho Rios, Jamaica**. The shore excursions are endless. You may choose to visit the famous Dunn's River Falls, which allows you to climb the 600 foot giant staircase. At Shaw Park Gardens you will have stunning views of Ocho Rios. If you like even more adventure you can soar through the rainforest canopy 45 feet above the forest floor. Perhaps you wish to stay aboard the ship and relax or take in the day's activities.

#### DAY 4 SATURDAY, March 13

The day at sea allows us to relax, take in a movie, shop at the boutiques, gamble or join our cruise director for activities.

#### DAY 5 SUNDAY, March 14

Today brings us to the **Panama Canal**. Optional excursions will be

available. Perhaps you will choose a cruise to learn more about the rainforest ecosystem and learn about the engineering feat required to move ships over a continental divide that separates two oceans. Get an up-close look at the rainforest canopy aboard an aerial tram. At the top, amazing views of the jungle and canal can be seen.

#### DAY 6 MONDAY, March 15

This is our last full day at sea to enjoy all the activities onboard the cruise ship.

#### DAY 7 TUESDAY, March 16

**Puntarenas, Costa Rica** is our port of call today. You may wish to take a scenic tour through the countryside, which offers views of green rolling hills and a chance to sample exotic tropical fruits at local markets. Perhaps a visit to the Monteverde Cloud Forest in the central highlands is something that interests you. Your guide will take you on a walk that travels on suspension bridges through the forest canopy and along trails on the forest floor. Quaker families that emigrated to Costa Rica in the 1950s started conservation efforts of the rain forest, which have kept it well preserved.

#### DAY 8 WEDNESDAY, March 17

Our port of call is **San Juan del Sur, Nicaragua**. You may choose to take an excursion to Masaya Market, known as the birth place of Nicaragua's best painters, artists, singers and craftspeople. Here you

can find handmade leather products, beautiful embroidered clothing, wood carvings and ceramics just to name a few. Lake Nicaragua is the tenth-largest lake in the world. If you choose this tour you will learn about the history that traces back to 606 A.D.

#### DAY 9 THURSDAY, March 18

We have a full day in the port of **Puerto Questzal, Guatemala**. Perhaps a drive through the picturesque countryside to Antigua is of interest. Here you can visit a Native Indian Music Museum and Coffee Museum, churches and a typical Old Spanish town plaza. View lovely gardens and stop at a Jade factory before returning to the ship.

#### DAY 10 FRIDAY, March 19

We arrive in the port of **Huatulco, Mexico** around noon today. Explore the countryside with stops to learn about some of the local customs. Take a catamaran and visit some of the beautiful bays with rock formations and blow holes. Tonight we have to pack as it is the last evening of our cruise.

#### DAY 11 SATURDAY, March 20

The day brings us to our port of disembarkation, **Acapulco, Mexico**. Depending on our flight schedule there may be time to visit the famous cliff divers of Acapulco. A shuttle awaits our arrival at the Minneapolis airport where it will bring us back to Central Wisconsin.

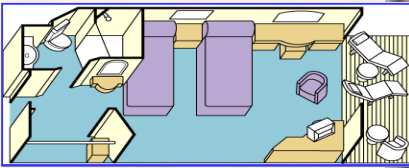

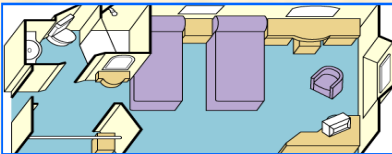

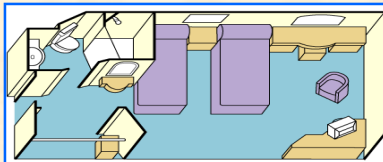
