Saturday, June 2, 2018

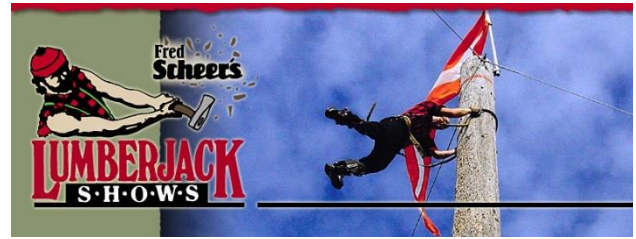
