## Mighty Mississippi #6 October 3-5, 2019

## Thursday, October 3, 2019

Welcome aboard our sixth Mighty Mississippi tour! We haven't been up the river in quite some time so for this tour we are heading to Minnesota. After our round of pick-ups we travel to Wabasha, MN, to the National Eagle Center. The **National Eagle Center** is home to many bald and golden eagles that cannot survive in the wilderness. Our **included** visit will allow us to see these truly magnificent birds up close.



We will learn

many interesting things about the eagles that make their home here. This area of the country is home to many bald eagles that live in the wild. Many choose to build their nests in the tall trees along the river valley. It will be fun to see how many eagles we can count while visiting this awesome place!

What is a size 638 ½ D and stands over 20 feet tall? The answer is the world's largest boot! It is located in Red Wing, MN, and it was made by the Red Wing Shoe Company. We will be stopping at the **Red Wing Shoe Company** to visit their **museum**. The museum is an **included stop** with some hands on things for us to do and also a video to watch to see how the famous footwear is made. Afterwards, we will have a bit of time to check out their store. It is not every day we get the

chance to see the world's largest boot so we will gather around to take an awesome group photo.

The **Rock Island Swing Bridge** connected the cities of Inver Grove Heights, MN, with St. Paul Park, MN. The bridge, many years ago, had two levels that allowed cars to travel on the lower deck and trains to travel on the upper deck. After many changes, today the bridge has been turned into a pier that is 670 feet long. At this **included stop** we will walk out to the end of the pier and see the most beautiful view of the majestic Mississippi River.



We continue on to Minneapolis MN, where we will have our **included dinner** at a local restaurant before arriving at our hotel in Mounds View, MN. You will have the evening to enjoy the heated indoor pool, hot tub or relax with friends poolside for an evening of socializing.

## <u>Friday, October 4, 2019</u>

Rise and shine to an **included delicious hot breakfast** located in our hotel. We travel this morning to Coon Rapids, MN, to the **Coon Rapids Dam Visitor Center**. Once at the dam we
