I want to spend my time doing the things that make me happy and avoid the things that make me sad. Very little walking and a few stairs; basically in and out of the coach.



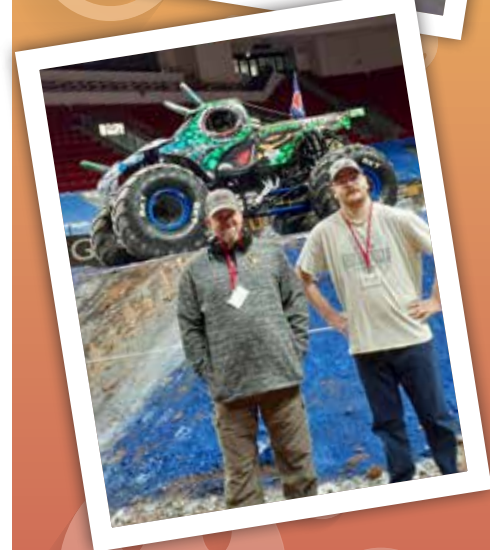
### MEDIUM LEVEL:

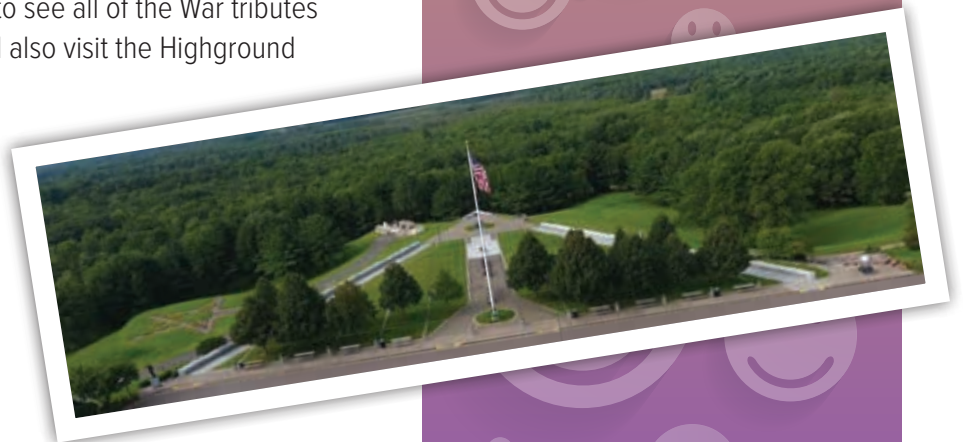
## Friday, September 15, 2023

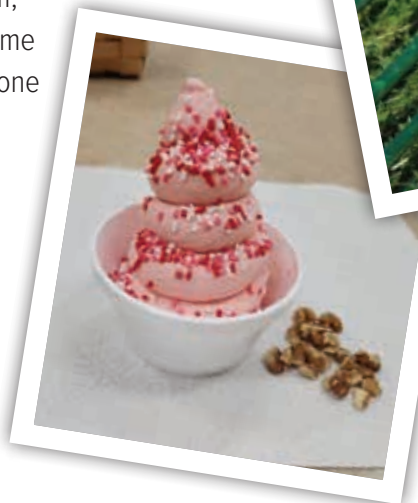
## Thursday, October 19, 2023

## General

### Tour Policies

Progressive Travel, Inc., is located at 211085 Highway 13, Spencer, Wisconsin 54479. We are responsible to the travelers for all services that are offered in connection with each tour. Progressive Travel, Inc., will make every attempt to comply with the itinerary developed for each tour. We do reserve the right to change the itinerary because of unforeseen circumstances.

All overnights will be double occupancy. Travelers may be in rooms occupied by a special tour chaperone. In the absence of our negligence, Progressive Travel, Inc., shall not be responsible for any property damage, loss of property, personal injury or death. Progressive Travel, Inc., shall not be responsible for any acts of the travelers during the tour. Special chaperones shall be permitted to obtain emergency medical services on behalf of the traveler if needed with the expense to be paid by the traveler.

Progressive Travel, Inc., shall not be held liable for delays caused by mechanical breakdowns, inclement weather, and any other unforeseen events. Alcoholic beverages and smoking are prohibited while on the motorcoach. Motorcoach transportation (not wheelchair accessible) will be the type of transportation unless otherwise stated.

### Reservations

A \$100.00 per person deposit is necessary to confirm a reservation for a multiple-day tour. Monthly payments would also be acceptable on those tours. Telephone reservations are accepted; however, a deposit must be received within 14 days. The remainder is due thirty (30) days prior to departure along with a completed passenger information form. On single-day tours, full payment must be received within 14 days of making the reservation. A completed passenger information form must be received in our office no later than 14 days prior to departure to assure the most recent medication list is included.

### Cancellations

If the need to cancel arises there will be no penalties if you have a substitute traveler unless there is a penalty from a vendor such as an airline for a name change, etc. Without a substitute, please see refund section.

### Refunds

All requests for refunds must be in writing. If canceled prior to departure: 60 days or more, 100% refunded unless specified differently on tour description; 15-59 days prior, 50% refunded; 0-14 days, No Refunds. Trip cancellation insurance is highly recommended.

### Right to Cancellation

Progressive Travel, Inc., reserves the right to cancel any tours that do not meet the minimum passenger requirement thirty (30) days prior to departure. All fees paid by any traveler will be returned within seven (7) working days. Progressive Travel, Inc., will notify all travelers in writing or by phone of any cancellations.

### Responsibility of the Participants

All cost related to travel to and from the departure point are the responsibility of the traveler. Any expense incurred by the traveler, other than the covered costs, are the responsibility of the traveler. We recommend \$25-\$35 per day spending money. The participants shall be entitled to bring one (1) suitcase and one (1) carry-on bag for overnight tours.

### Emergency Medical Care Authorization

All medical information should be included on the passenger information form. A medication list must be completed for all tours and received in our office no later than 15 days prior to departure.

## Travel Insurance Information

### Trip Cancellation and Interruption

Trip Cancellation and Interruption pays for forfeited, non-refundable, unused payments or deposits if due to:

- Sickness, injury or death of you, a Traveling Companion or Family Member.
- Unforeseeable circumstances such as jury duty, weather, a flat tire, or involvement in or delay due to a traffic accident on the way to the airport, or strike.

### Reasons Not Covered

- Travel arrangements cancelled by the tour operator, airline, or cruise line.
- Change in plans ("I just don't want to go.").
- Financial circumstances ("I can't afford to go.").
- Any government regulation or prohibition, war, civil disorder, nuclear reaction or contamination.

### Other Benefits

- \$100 Travel Delay
- \$500 Baggage and Travel Documents
- \$1000 Medical Expense
- \$20,000 Emergency Medical Transportation
- \$10,000 Accidental Death and Dismemberment

### Pre-Existing Medical Condition Exclusion Applicable to all Coverages

Travel Guard will not pay for loss or expense incurred as the result of Injury or Sickness of an insured or Family Member which manifests itself during the 60 days immediately preceding and including the Effective Date, unless the condition is controlled through the taking of prescription drugs or medication and remains controlled throughout the 60 day period. A sickness has manifested itself when: (a) medical care or treatment has been given; (b) there exist symptoms which would cause a reasonably prudent person to seek diagnosis, care, or treatment.

**Note:** The above exclusion will be waived if Insurance is purchased within 7 days of initial trip payment. This is applicable to all coverages contained in the policy. In the event that a claim is filed, the injury or illness must be substantiated to our Claims Department.

**Termination Date:** All coverage ends on the earlier of: (a) the date the trip is completed; (b) the scheduled trip completion date; (c) the Insured's arrival at the return destination on a round trip, or the destination on a one-way trip; or (d) cancellation of the trip covered by the policy. The Effective Date is the date the premium is paid.

**Insurance Premium:** The cost per person is determined by the age of the traveler and the cost of the tour, please call our office to get the actual cost of the particular tour that is of interest to your traveler.
